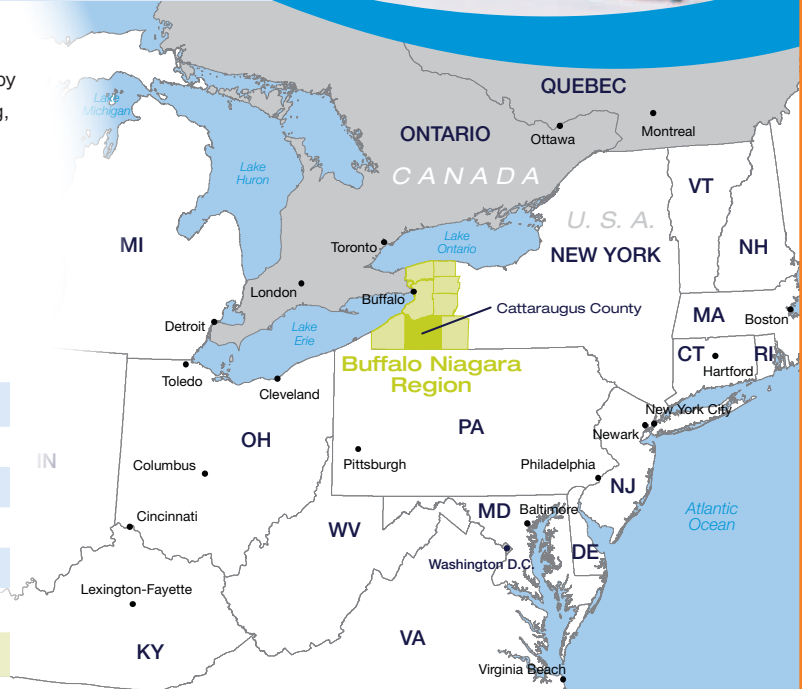
Cattaraugus County is the heart of Western New York's ski country. Holiday Valley Resort in Ellicottville has 52 trails that cover over 1,100 acres, while nearby HoliMont is the largest private ski area in North America with 50 trails for skiing, hiking, sledding and snowboarding. Visit Allegany State Park's 65,000 acres of woodlands, trails, beaches and other areas that make it the largest in the New York State Park System. A number of museums, bed and breakfasts, and campgrounds dot the county's landscape. Nestled into the town of Allegany at the foot of the Allegheny Mountains, the picturesque St. Bonaventure University (founded by the Franciscan Friars in 1858), is a college basketball hot bed and home to more than 2,400 students.

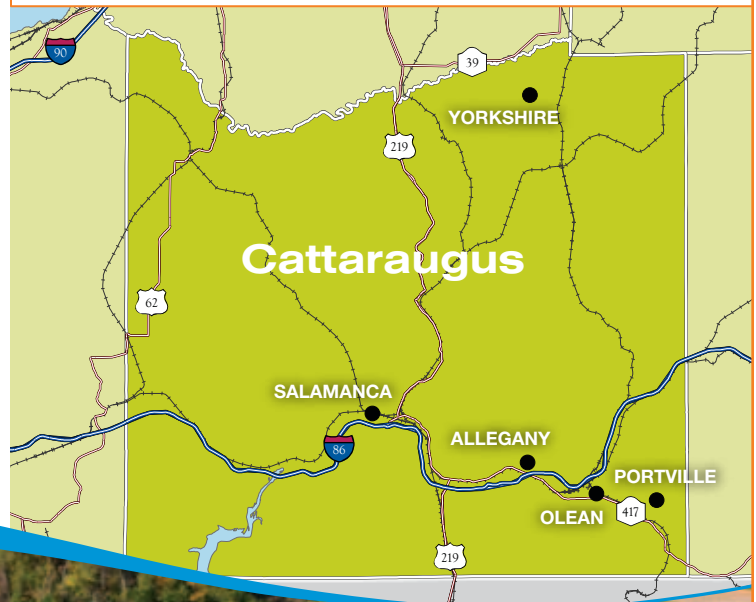
